DeGroote School of Medicine, Faculty of Health Sciences at McMaster University, Hamilton, Ontario invites applications for the geographic full time position of academic General Obstetrician/Gynecologist with appropriate experience. The successful candidate will join the staff at McMaster University Medical Centre. The current McMaster complement of nineteen generalists offers care in Obstetrics and Gynecology for the City of Hamilton, LHINs 3 and 4 (Waterloo Wellington, Hamilton Niagara, Haldimand and Brant) covering a region of 30,000 deliveries per year. The successful academic generalist OB/GYN will have training and experience in obstetrics and gynecology. Special consideration will be given to candidates with additional postgraduate training beyond a residency program, such as fellowship, masters or other advanced degree. The successful candidate is expected to have experience and commitment to teaching all levels of learners, including medical students, residents and clinical fellows and will provide leadership and training to future physicians. The candidate will be expected to fully participate in all of the appropriate departmental and divisional administrative and educational activities. Candidates must have demonstrated capability and interest in clinical research and show evidence of a history of research productivity to align with the departmental academic mission and vision. This is a full time faculty position for a period of three years (renewable). Applicants should be certified (or eligible for certification) by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and must be licensed (or eligible for licensure) in the Province of Ontario. Academic rank will be commensurate with the candidate's qualifications and experience. Salary is composed of, largely, fee-for-service activities. All qualified applicants are encouraged to apply; however, Canadian citizens and permanent residents will be considered first for this position.
