- Complete geotechnical inspections of assigned work areas, raise issues and report anomalies
- Perform geotechnical monitoring and testing for earth dam construction, foundation approvals, compaction testing/lift approvals, materials sampling at placement areas and pit inspections to assess borrow source material
- Conduct the monthly scheduled instrumentation readings including slope indicators, piezometers and standpipes
- Complete routine maintenance of instrumentation in your assigned area of responsibility
- Craft, maintain and follow up with both the documented reporting and informal communication loops required for the completion of field activities (non-conformance reporting, monthly area surveillance reports and cross shift reporting)
