 - Use lessons learned from failure analysis results to identify improvement opportunities which includes researching and implementing technical improvements on mining assets through the management of change (MOC) process to improve availability, safety, functionality and/or reliability
 - Support the expertise in reliability engineering techniques (reliability centered maintenance, failure mode effects analysis) and apply as required
 - Ensure condition monitoring programs are implemented based on the equipment strategy and support data analytics in order to minimize equipment failure and downtime
