POSITION ACCOUNTABILITIES:Reconciling and analyzing monthly tax account balances and details to confirm their validity and investigating variances; Accurately preparing and filing all assigned commodity tax returns prior to the legislated deadlines, as well as reviewing and reconciling the related notices of assessment; Reviewing specific transactions for commodity tax compliance and minimization and making any appropriate adjustments; Monitoring and improving the commodity tax return process and identifying commodity tax opportunities and exposures; Responding to routine commodity tax queries from business units; Assisting in developing and executing commodity tax compliance and recovery initiatives; and Assisting the Manager, Commodity Tax to assess the effects of commodity tax legislation changes, including maintaining and validating SAP tax logic.
