- Review the performance of consultants and contractors to verify that quality, cost and schedule objectives are maintained;
- Prepare and review project cost estimates for appropriation of funds relating to facilities (estimates may range up to \$10M);
- Negotiate with the construction manager, contractors, suppliers and consultants to ensure the Company derives maximum benefits from its expenditures;

- Ensure a proper liaison and working relationship the Historic Sites and Monuments Board with respect to projects in Company owned Heritage Buildings as well as with municipal and government code and transport authorities with respect to any issues to be resolved;
- Ensure that CP safety requirements are adhered to on all sites;
- Manage electrical projects on a day to day basis to ensure completion within schedule and budget.
- Ensure any related environmental issues are dealt with according to company mandated policies and local codes, as they relate to projects
- Prepare budget requirements for current and four year planning;
