These systems typically involve large amount of non-IT developed code or a significant hands-on joint development effort between IT and staff embedded in a business line. Serves as a local backstop and point of responsibility for End User and Low Code development with GTA. Has a dotted line reporting responsibility for Low Code local experts in each of the GTA business silos. Acts a local point of focus for emerging low code / end user computing technologies such as PowerApps / CoPilot / AppSheets

Leads and oversees the department globally; ensuring business and technology strategies, plans and initiatives are executed and delivered in compliance with governing regulations, and internal policies and procedures.

Delivery and management of highly complex technology programs which consist of multiple IT projects for multiple business partners and stakeholders, across multiple business units. Serve as a sponsor for driving down operational costs using Rapid Application Development, Artificial Intelligence and Robotic Process Automation within the Operations area.
