- Degree in the natural resource field or equivalent as recognized by the Forest Professionals British Columbia, and a minimum of two (2) years' experience (gained over the last 10 years) or an equivalent combination of education and experience in a resource management related field.
- Registered member in good standing as a Professional Forester with the Forest Professionals British Columbia (FPBC) or immediately eligible for registration with the FPBC.
- Applicants who do not meet the professional requirement may be considered at a lower level, subject to confirmation of eligibility for registration as Forester in Training (FIT) or Allied Forester in Training (ASFIT) immediately upon employment with the Ministry.

Preference may be given to applicants with one (1) or more of the following:

- Experience in consulting, negotiating and resolving conflicts with stakeholders in natural resource management.

- Demonstrated experience with administrative and/or operational activities in tenures and land management.
- Experience and/or training in contract monitoring and administration.
