University Business Services (UBS) is a division of the Office of the Vice President Operations and Administration and provides a number of different services to students, staff, faculty and guests of the University. The Senior Cook is responsible for the preparation of delicious menu items as determined by the chef for the Hub cafeteria or the student residence. Additional responsibilities will include:

- Working collaboratively with team members

- Assists chef and manager with planning of cafeteria and catering food.
- Complies with required food handling and safety regulations, standards, practices and procedures and facilitates kitchen safety and sanitation

Qualifications

- Successful completion of a secondary school graduation diploma.
- Minimum three (3) years of experience in a full service kitchen, understanding recipes, organizing, arranging and setting up buffets or banquets, cooking and producing large quantities of food to meet the demands of cafeteria and catering operations.
- Knowledge of food service procedures, preparation and production.
- Knowledge of WHMIS.
- Knowledge of Food Safety and Physical Safety rules.
- Toronto Public Health Food Handlers or Recognized Serve Safe Certification is an asset.
