We are seeking someone with a breadth of experience in areas such as financial risk, payment products, clearing and settlement, banking, and prior experience working on large projects. The Future State of Retail Batch (FSRB) project is a key priority for Payments Canada over the next few years. As a Senior Risk Analyst dedicated to this initiative, you will be a key member of a team working to identify, define and document payment processes and assist in the development of the conceptual design, high level requirements and detailed requirements.
