- * Confirm performance of die by installing die, inspecting operation of automation or manual press die, making adjustments, and comparing a finished product to specification.
- * Repair die - double, triple hit, mislocation
- * Preventive maintenance on all tools and dies.
- * Operate tool and die room machines and cooperated with CNC/CMM team.
- * Measure parts to spec and have a basic working knowledge of GD&T.
- * Die repairs in the press

- Clean up after repairs
- Any other duties assigned by the tool and die team lead
