### Description

We are hiring a permanent part time (0.8 FTE) Residential Care Coordinator to join our team at Dr. Helmcken Memorial Hospital in Clearwater, B.C. We are seeking nurses with residential experience and strong leadership skills to join our team.

The Dr. Helmcken Memorial Hospital is a Level 1 Community Hospital in the Thompson Cariboo Shuswap health service area. Located in Clearwater, North of Kamloops, the hospital offers services including surgical, inpatient and 24 hour emergency.

The Residential Care Coordinator (RCC) is responsible for the coordination of day to day operations and quality resident care within a designated clinical area(s). This position supports the seamless movement of residents through the healthcare system and in accessing appropriate resources.

The RCC also:

- Supervises as well as serves as a role model and a resource to staff for clinical decision-making, clinical assessments of residents and in the counseling and education of families.

- Reviews, analyzes and makes recommendations on the development of administrative systems such as policies, procedures and standards of resident care, adequate staffing levels, and a continuous quality improvement environment.

- Liaises with the interdisciplinary team for identification, coordination and efficient utilization of resources as well as plans for staff educational needs.

Shifts of work will be four 8 hour work days per week 08:00 to 16:00 with expected days of work Monday to Thursday. This position offers the opportunity to play an integral role in the development and leadership with staff. As it is located in a rural setting, there are other opportunities for learning in terms of staffing and taking on other managerial duties.
