Indigenous Peoples make up 3.7 per cent of the population in the Fraser Health Region, with 58 per cent identifying as First Nations, 41.4 per cent identifying as Metis and 0.6 per cent identifying as Inuit with a total population of more than 62,000 Indigenous peoples. Our region is home to 32 First Nations communities and five Chartered Metis Community Associations. Our team of nearly 40,000 staff, medical staff and volunteers is dedicated to serving our patients, families and communities to deliver on our vision: better health, best in health care.
