The BTA has extensive experience and is an accredited professional (i.e. a professional engineer, registered architect, technologist or other specialized building system expert with additional specialized training). The BTA is a recognized expert by the clients, stakeholders, the construction industry, and the professional design community, and is the technical authority within RPD. The Building Technology Advisor provides strategic technical advice to RPD and Provincial Government clients on all aspects of the selection, evaluation, design, and application of various building technology systems. Each Building Technology Advisor addresses a specialized discipline within the

building sciences and is responsible for providing strategic advice of internal or outsourced design and planning that affect building systems and fabric.
