#### Job Summary

The Digital Communications Advisor works as part of a team responsible for the management and ongoing development of the CSIS websites (intranet and Canada.ca).

- Create, design and maintain all aspects/functions of the CSIS websites to ensure they meet the Service's communications objectives and standards.
- Administer and coordinate posting of files prepared by employees and ensure that the CSIS websites conform to CSIS guidelines, government requirements on security, privacy, accessibility, official languages, and common look and feel standards.
- Research and advise on web technology and digital publishing, upgrades, purchases and other web-related tools.
- Collaborate with colleagues on committees/workgroups/meetings by advising on web issues and by evaluating and commenting on proposals.
- Act as client contact and interface regarding the Service's web issues.
- Create links between CSIS and other government and security related sites.
- Monitor usage of the CSIS websites and prepare regular reports.

### Education

- Undergraduate degree and two (2) years of experience within the last six (6) years.
- College diploma and four (4) years of experience within the last six (6) years.

The educational program must be from an accredited learning institution recognized in Canada. #### Security Requirements
