You will be part of a growing and dynamic team, addressing our current and future data needs including data integration, visualization and data management. As a Business Intelligence Specialist, you will be able to contribute to supporting, enhancing and maintaining CSIS's Business Intelligence program. We are currently looking to fill roles that include BI platform administration, ETL design and data modeling. Core responsibilities include:

- Installation, maintenance and configuration of business intelligence platforms
- Managing user access and licensing

- Strong query/data manipulation skills, especially utilizing SQL.
- Experience in the development and communication of policies, procedures and/or standards related to IT and technical concepts to non-technical clients.
- Experience in researching and/or applying current trends, methodologies, standards, practices and/or products in an IT environment.

Security Requirements
