- Consult with clients and colleagues, obtain and provide information, discuss and confirm requirements, and provide support in the delivery of digital communications services.
- Research and analyze trends and emerging issues in the digital communications environments, and report on findings.
- Provide support in the planning, coordination and management of regular updates of information on CSIS websites.
- Keep current on web and digital media techniques and their application.
