Collaborate with application development teams to gather functional and non-functional requirements for a specific project and articulate how the solution addresses those requirements. Directly support large initiatives, including the creation of project artifacts. Produce and present materials to senior staff. Publish all documents to the EA repository and maintain/enhance said repository. Competencies: Ability to balance tactical needs with longer-term goals.
