The Vessel Operator is responsible for coordinating all voyage activities. This includes interpreting and implementing the charter party terms and conditions of assigned vessels, monitoring and updating voyage information, settling of final vessel accounts and performing post-voyage analysis. This position:

- Manages voyages with all stakeholders and initiates pre-emptive or corrective action as required.
- Responsible for reviewing, implementing, and optimizing voyage and bunkering plans to maximize cargo intake, reduce costs, minimize delays, and meet customer requirements.
- Engages and instructs port agents, surveyors, and weather routing companies in a timely and efficient manner.
- Generates laytime calculations and settles demurrage/dispatch.

- Coordinates timely and accurate instructions to vessel masters/owners, while performing various post-voyage analysis.
- Evaluates and approves payment of port disbursement accounts, monitors the issuance and availability of cargo documents.
