A QA tester works with the development team to produce top-quality software.

Foundation Level ISTQB Software Tester Certification or completion of an IS or equivalent diploma (with a concentration in software development).

2 years software testing experience

1 year SQL and database experience.

2 years telecommunications and cable experience, with clear understanding of service delivery processes including ordering, provisioning and billing is required.

Experience writing test plans and test cases.

Excellent analytical skills and problem solving skills, with the ability to propose practical solutions to complex problems.

Excellent task planning skills, strong attention to detail and ability to deal with shifting priorities are essential.
