Provide support, maintenance and enhancements to systems including databases, business intelligence (BI) systems and Extract-Transform-Load (ETL) processes. Provide user support and training on reports, dashboards and other business intelligence solutions.

Responsibilities Support business intelligence reporting and analysis within The Chang School by: Soliciting requirements from end users for data analysis requests, new reports and new dashboards. Creating complex queries, dashboards and datasets for use by internal customers. Analyzing and assessing trends from data to provide insights and recommendations.

Support end users within The Chang School by: Providing guidance and technical support on dashboards, self-serve reporting and other business intelligence solutions. Developing new documentation and manuals describing the functionality of business intelligence platforms such as Tableau and SSRS.
