Description

Posting 21-24 (Regular full time position)

The following statements are intended to describe the general nature and level of work performed. They are not representing an exhaustive list of all responsibilities, duties and skills required.

Bishopâ€™s University is seeking an Athletic Therapist for a regular full-time position in the Sports Medicine department. Reporting to the Manager of Sports Medicine, the incumbent will provide athletic therapy services and assist with the assessment, management and treatment of acute and chronic athletic injuries among the varsity teams at Bishopâ€™s University. Designing rehabilitative programs and incorporating necessary therapeutic modalities when needed, the incumbent will also assist in the prevention of athletic injuries using various prophylactic taping and bracing techniques, as well as education towards training. This position has a workweek of 35 hours from Monday to Friday as well as irregular schedules including weekends and evenings.

Nature of Duties & Responsibilities:

- Provide on-site athletic therapy coverage for practices, home and away games;
- Support the education and supervision of students who act as student trainers; and assist in delivering CCES and concussion education seminars;
- Collaborate with other members of the Sports Medicine, Health Services and Athletics departments to ensure quality health care delivery for athletes and patients;
- Support and assist with the Sports Medicine Clinicâ€™s daily operations;
- Support and assist with ensuring students follow all public health sanitary guidelines
- Offer administrative support for insurance billing, appointment scheduling, financial reports, evaluation and maintenance of annual records;
- Assist with inventory management;
- Order equipment and supplies as requested by the -Manager of Sports Medicine;
- Flexible schedule as most tasks require the ability to work non-traditional hours, often for extended periods of time outside the course of a typical working day;
- Other tasks as assigned.
