Job Overview Reporting to the shift supervisor, you will be responsible for operating plant equipment in the assigned operating unit in a safe and efficient manner. You will operate, monitor and adjust plant equipment and process variables to optimize production in an environmentally responsible manner.

Key Accountabilities

- Develop operations procedures, hazardous energy isolation sheets and operator rounds, as well as perform commissioning and start up activities, and participate in the operator training program (all prior to startup)
- Operate plant equipment safely according to established practices, procedures and operating guidelines
- Conduct regular equipment checks and perform basic troubleshooting
- Maintain equipment by conducting preventative maintenance including regular equipment checks, troubleshooting, diagnosing a problem, prepare equipment for maintenance, performing basic repairs, initiating maintenance request and preparing area for maintenance
- Ensure the safety of personnel working within the assigned area and ensure personal protective equipment and other plant policies are followed during operations

Required Qualifications Experience and Education:

- Relevant hydrocarbon or petrochemical operating experience within oil sands, refining, petrochemical, gas plants and/or upgrading and/or pulp and paper
- Commissioning, start-up and shut-down, and/or turnaround experience within an paraffinic froth treatment plant would be an asset
- Experience coaching, training and/or mentoring junior staff is an asset
- High School Diploma or General Education Diploma (GED)
- Possess a valid driver's licence and a clean driving record

Skills and Knowledge:

- Process safety management (PSM) knowledge is an asset
- Ability to read and understand process and instrument diagrams
- Working knowledge of procedure writing and updating; Work Notification Skills would be an asset (SAP)
- An exceptionally strong safety mindset
- Strong problem solving, prioritization, communication and decision making skills

Working Conditions
