Interior Health is seeking a relief part-time Occupational Therapist to join the Quick Response Team based out of Penticton Regional Hospital (PRH). This position has an office beside the Emergency Department at PRH, where clients are assigned to them, but will work with their clients in the community at their client's homes.

The successful Occupational Therapist will work independently, yet collaboratively as part of a multidisciplinary rehabilitation team providing inpatient, outpatient, and community occupational therapy services including assessment, treatment planning and implementation, program planning, consultation, equipment prescription and education to the clients and/or their caregivers to promote functional independence and enable the client to achieve and maintain optimal health outcomes.

This position is relief part-time (40.5 hours bi-weekly); however, additional casual hours are often available, if desired. Shifts are scheduled on a three week rotation: Mondays, Tuesdays, and every 3rd Wednesday, as well as every 3rd weekend, from 10:00 - 15:30.
