Description

About the College

The College of Physicians and Surgeons of British Columbia regulates the practice of medicine under the authority of provincial law. All physicians who practise medicine in the province must be registrants of the College. The College's overriding interest is the protection and safety of patients.

About the Board and committees

A Board of 10 registrants and six members of the public appointed by the Ministry of Health govern the College. Under the legislation, the College has many committees made up of board members, medical professionals and public representatives.
