This position is overtime eligible and will be part of an on-call rotating schedule and provide emergency support, as required. The regular work schedule for this position will be:

- Week 2 - Monday to Thursday 9 hours / day Friday is a Regular Day Off (RDO)

Please note that hours of work may need to be extended as business needs arise. The successful candidates will have to travel to other company locations for temporary assignments, meetings or training which would involve overnight stays away from home.*This position is eligible for domestic relocation assistance, but is not eligible for cross-border relocation assistance. - Independently perform installation, testing, repair and maintenance on compressor station equipment and other facilities relevant to the pipeline system, as required
- Perform routine and major maintenance on VFD compressor packages, gas compressor units and associated auxiliary equipment
- Perform emergency repairs to meet customer and client needs

- Occasionally perform Mechanical and Pipeline work as required
- Active control of contractors
