The Contract Analyst/Secondary Sourcing ensures that category value is sustained beyond contract formation and supports the Master Data team, BU/Projects teams or Category Leads to maintain accurate contract and pricing status. The position requires technical expertise of these complex subcategories with process and commercial skills capable of supporting multiple Category Leads that may be located in multiple geographies.
