The Project Leader resides in-house with the group.

- â€¢ Oversee the continuous development and program activities of a Project, including supervision of youth Participants and Community Partnerships.

- â€¢ Facilitate group learning through delivery of Katimavik's competency-based learning modules, tools, and resources, and through leading group discussions, activities, and reflection exercises.

- â€¢ Foster meaningful partnerships with local Indigenous communities and organizations to facilitate Truth and Reconciliation learning and activities.

- â€¢ Facilitate alumni relations, support recruitment initiatives, and implement program initiatives into the Project.

- â€¢ Support the National Experience program in the reporting and execution of advancement strategies for organizational growth.
