The Vice President works collaboratively with key stakeholders, including the financial leaders of PHSA's agency organizations as well as government officials and others, providing leadership and consultation related to the organization's financial strategy. The Vice President is responsible and accountable for all processes related to organizational business planning and financial reporting, and ensures these align to strategy and prioritize achievement of performance objectives. The Vice President will be tasked with developing new practices such as activity-based funding, performance management and the use of finance as a strategic tool. As a leader of a team of professionals, the Vice President is also responsible for supporting their team to ensure a culture of strategic business support and customer service.
