Site Reliability Specialist

This corporate posting will also be used to establish a cross-ministry eligibility list to fill future permanent vacancies in multiple ministries and locations identified in this posting. Positions from the list will be offered in rank order, as vacancies arise, based on the locations applicants have selected during the hiring process. Some positions may be performed from any approved location within the province of BC through a voluntary telework agreement (with conditions as set out in applicable employer policies), other positions may have office based requirements. Applicants will be asked to indicate their preferred work location(s) at a later stage in the process.

- Minimum two (2) years' experience with continuous integration, continuous delivery, and continuous deployment principles.
