The opportunity

Reporting to the Regional Director, the Manager, Pipeline Team - Central Region leads a team of approximately 20 pipeline technicians geographically dispersed across the region. You will contribute to the development of the strategy, goals and objectives for the Region and translate them for the Pipeline Team. In this role, you will also contribute to the development, assessment, and commissioning of Capacity Capital projects; manage the operation and maintenance of compression pulldown units; support pipe integrity program work; support damage prevention requirements for the Region; and contribute to the full life cycle integration of assets for Canada Gas.

This position requires candidates to:

- Travel to other company locations for temporary assignments, meetings or training which would involve some overnight stays away from home (approximately 25% travel)
- Have and maintain a valid Driver's License

- Provide a Driver's Abstract for review

- Successfully complete a pre-employment medical screen including drug and alcohol testing
