The Specialist is responsible for monitoring and reporting on the College's progress towards a sustainable campus through third-party reporting frameworks and other means. The Specialist provides key information and recommendations to guide strategic sustainability directions of the college and identifies priorities for advancing College sustainability.

Using a data-driven approach, the Specialist identifies and prioritizes projects and activities based on the depth of impact to financial, environmental and social conditions.
