BCTS operations are guided by three overarching principles, forest sector safety, reconciliation with Indigenous Peoples and sustainable forest management.

The GIS Analyst conducts advanced spatial data analysis in support of program and management decision making on resource planning, land management and other program issues. This role provides expert advice to clients, business area staff, contractors and business area specialists in the initiation, design, and specifications of projects, types of source data required and available, data base structure, limitations and related specialized applications. The GIS Analyst also develops or contributes to the development and implementation of quality assurance processes, consistent with provincial standards for the business area, including identifying inefficiencies and problems associated with provincial standards, procedures and policies; makes recommendations for improvements to corporate data integrity working groups.

Qualifications for this role include:

Diploma or degree in geographic information systems, or in a related field, such as natural resources, geography or Data Science and three years of related experience.
