If you have what it takes to lead by example in maintaining good public relations, projecting professional service standards and ensuring that the customer experience is a priority at all times, while promoting efficient mail delivery and workplace health and safety, Canada Post is where you want to be.

As a Letter Carrier Supervisor, you will supervise the activities of a team of letter carriers, mail service couriers and RSMCs (rural and suburban mail carriers) assigned to a Postal station. In so doing, you will play a pivotal role in ensuring that proper procedures are followed in the handling and delivery of mail relay bundles and the administration of funds collected.

These are 6-month temporary/term assignments, with a possibility of extension and permanent job opportunities (90% of term hires, who successfully complete their 6-month Probationary Review, are extended and obtain a permanent full-time position within 1 to 2 years).

There are various work schedules, with start times as early as 03:30 a.m. and end times as late as 9:00 p.m.

An Eligibility List will be created to staff future job opportunities and will be valid for a period of 1 year.

You bring a successful track record to the role of Supervisor, Letter Carriers:

• A high school diploma or provincial equivalent (GED); equivalent experience may be accepted in lieu of a high school diploma.

• At least 1 year of experience managing a team, OR at least 2 years' experience working within a unionized environment.

• A working knowledge of Microsoft Office.

• A valid permanent driver's licence (no graduated or temporary licence).

• A satisfactory safe driving record per Canada Post's Driver Safety Program, which includes:

o Not having received more than 2 moving violations in the last 3 years;

o Not having had more than 3 demerit points assigned in one single violation; and

o Not having your licence suspended, or a prohibition of any kind, in the last 3 years.

• Proficiency in English.
