The successful candidate will often be performing these activities near high pressure pipelines and other energized facilities.

What you'll do

- Strictly adhere to workplace safety policies, regulations and internal operating procedures
- Communicate any unsafe conditions or accidents/injuries in a timely manner to the supervisor in order to facilitate prompt corrective action and reporting
- Report equipment or vehicle defects, accidents, traffic violations, or damage to the equipment upon immediate observation
- Operate Equipment near and around above and below ground facilities
- Responsible for shipping, receiving, loading and unloading of construction materials and equipment for projects
- Perform routine daily pre-use inspections to ensure safe operability of all equipment
- Perform minor maintenance activities such as equipment lubrication to ensure equipment is maintained and is clean
- Assist team with pre-job planning of all ground disturbances to ensure safety and compliance of excavations
- Assume the role of the excavation coordinator as it pertains to TC Energy operating procedures
- Support the team in other general pipeline maintenance activities as required
