Land and Resource Coordinator (Wildfire)

The Land and Resource Coordinator (Wildfire) works in diverse teams, gathers, and manages complex natural resource data, completes analysis and develops land management options. This role provides expertise and advice to statutory decision makers, facilitates, and coordinates projects and engages directly with a wide variety of stakeholders to support wildfire risk reduction and other wildfire management initiatives and decisions.

Working for BC Public Service offers a competitive salary, diverse work environment, a healthy work/life balance, and excellent benefits. In addition to the base salary for Professional Employee Association members, there is an allowance to cover professional fees, strong dental and medical plans and much more.
