• Business analysis experience including working with business users and/or subject matter experts to produce requirements (i.e., gap analysis, business process design, business rules, risk analysis and other analysis work products).

• Experience with each phase of the project management life cycle and/or systems development life cycle (SDLC).

• Experience leading/managing external contractors.
