Relevant du ou de la Directeur.trice des services auxiliaires et sous les conseils du ou de la Directeur.trice technique du Theatre Centennial, le ou la titulaire du poste aidera et effectuera des operations techniques pour le Theatre Centennial, Bandeen Hall et Turner Studio tout en s'assurant que les pratiques sont conformes aux lois, reglements et politiques et pratiques etablies par l'Universite. Ce poste a une semaine de travail de 32,5 heures et comprend des horaires flexibles incluant les jours, les soirs et les fins de semaine. Ce poste ne depassera pas deux ans.

Nature des taches

- Installer, exploiter et desinstaller les elements et accessoires sceniques et les equipements audio-visuelles, sonores et d'eclairage;
- Faire fonctionner et programmer les consoles d'eclairage et les panneaux de son lors des enregistrements et des evenements en direct ;
- Aide a la diffusion d'evenements en direct ;
- Assure la liaison avec les client.e.s et s'assure que leurs besoins sont satisfaits;
- Coordonner les exigences techniques des evenements a venir et assurer que les besoins de mise en place et techniques sont rencontres;
- Maintenir et reparer les equipements et composantes;
- Aider le ou la Directeur.trice technique, notamment pour la conception des plans d'eclairage, la correspondance et la formation des employes etudiants;
- Se tient au courant des tendances emergentes de l'industrie afin de pouvoir conseiller les client.e.s;
- Aide aux exigences de sante et de securite dans le theatre, c'est-a-dire ; assurer l'utilisation appropriee des outils electriques, l'utilisation appropriee et le respect des equipements de securite - c'est-a-dire ; harnais, nacelle elevatrice, ascenseur, veille a l'utilisation de bottes de securite et de casques de protection au besoin;
- Effectuer toutes autres taches connexes au besoin.

The following statements are intended to describe the general nature and level of work performed. They are not representing an exhaustive list of all responsibilities, duties and skills required.

Bishop's University is seeking a Theater Technician for a temporary full-time position. Reporting to the Director of Ancillary Services and with guidance from the Technical Director of Centennial Theatre, the incumbent will assist and perform technical operations of the theatre facilities, including Centennial Theatre, Bandeen Hall, and Turner Studio Theatre, ensuring the practices comply with laws, regulations, and set policies & practices of Bishop's University. This position has a work week of 32. 5 hours and includes flexible scheduling including days, evenings and weekends. The duration of this employment shall not exceed two (2) years.

Nature of duties and responsibilities

- Install, operate, and uninstall scenic elements and accessories, audio-visual, sound, and lighting equipment;
- Operate and program lighting consoles and sound boards during recordings and live events; Assists with the streaming of live events;
- Liaises with clients and ensures that their needs are met;
- Coordinate technical requirements for upcoming event and ensure technical and set-up needs are met;
- Maintain and repair components and equipment;
- Assist the Technical Director, including conception of lighting plans, correspondence, and training student employees;
- Keeps up to date on emerging trends in the industry to be able to advise and counsel clients;
- Assists with health and safety requirements in the theatre ie; ensuring the proper use of electrical tools, proper use and adherence to safety equipment - ie; harnesses, cherry picker, elevator, ensures the use of safety boots and hard hats as required;
- Performs additional similar / related task as required.
