The following statements are intended to describe the general nature and level of work performed.

Bishopâ€™s University is seeking a Refrigeration Mechanic for a regular full-time position.

Reporting to the Manager of Facilities, the incumbent will install, verify, adjust, service, repair and operate machinery such as compression, ventilation, refrigeration and chilling systems. The incumbent will also perform preventive and corrective maintenance and cleaning jobs on various equipment and mechanical rooms. This position has a work week of 40 hours from Monday to Friday with occasional evenings and weekends as required.

Nature of Duties & Responsibilities:

- Performs preventive and corrective maintenance of refrigeration, air conditioning, compression, heating and ventilation systems, including those with ammonia and/or other coolant;
- Cleans and lubricates parts, changes filters and fine tune the installations to ensure that they perform and respect all specified rules and regulations;
- Verifies the performance and operation of any refrigeration and/or cooling equipment as per specifications;
- Keep a registry of the cooling refrigeration gases;
- Responds to any incoming calls and/or work orders related to all refrigeration, air conditioning, compression, heating and ventilation systems and performs corrective measures, if necessary;
- Conceives and elaborates additions and/or modifications to the existing systems, prepares the list of any parts or material needed;
- Prepares start-up and shutdown of refrigeration, air conditioning, compression, heating and ventilation systems including cleaning the condensers for summer season and changes all the filters of the equipment;
- Maintains and repairs commercial heat pumps, fridges and freezers (walk in) including filters;

- Part of the on-call schedule for off hour emergencies;
- Snow removal;
- Assists in campus emergency calls from security when required;
- Other tasks as assigned.

- Nettoyer et lubrifier les pièces, changer les filtres et, affiner les installations afin d'assurer qu'elles fonctionnent et respectent tous les règlements spécifiques;
- Vérifier la performance et l'opération des équipements de réfrigération et/ou de refroidissement selon le cahier des charges;
- Tenir un registre des gaz réfrigérants de refroidissement;
- Répondre aux appels entrants et/ou bons de travail liés aux systèmes de réfrigération, air climatisé, compression, chauffage et ventilation et effectuer des mesures correctives au besoin;
