The primary duties of the Senior Advisor, First Nations Relations are centered on conducting consultations for the use of natural resources on Crown land. The advisor determines the impact on First Nations identified or potential traditional use areas.

You will liaise with First Nations on resource applications, work with ministry staff, and act as an expert on the legal and procedural needs of First Nations consultation. It is crucial to take a collaborative approach to establish and maintain productive working relationships with a wide variety of contacts.
