The issues and proposals regard the use of natural resources on public land and the impact on First Nations identified Indigenous interests. This position carries out consultations and negotiations to address First Nations' concerns while minimizing negative impacts on provincial revenues. The Senior Advisor, First Nations Relations is a recommending authority to Ministry Executive on whether these projects should proceed.
