Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Translating independently, without supervision, a wide variety of texts from English into French (and occasionally from French into English) including complex, critical and specialized texts

Editing regular and specialized French texts (and occasionally English texts) translated by suppliers before delivery to internal clients who may include the Board of Directors, the CEO's Office, Vice-Presidents, etc.

Proofreading print-ready literature in English and in French for high-profile products, including numismatic certificates, packaging, Web materials, etc. aimed at national and international clients

Adapting advertising and marketing texts and slogans with localized, culturally-accurate equivalents

Advising clients regarding French and English grammar, terminology and style

Helping to update the electronic in-house terminology database

Ensuring lean and efficient use of resources (optimizing choice of texts for in-house translation vs. outsourcing, coaching clients on best practices, etc.)

Occasionally replacing the Coordinator to process translation requests and negotiating with clients and suppliers about deadlines
