This position has specific operational responsibilities in the area of coordinating the Chemical Safety Program, WHMIS Program, and is responsible for overseeing the Hazardous Waste Management Program. Develop and implement specific safety and health training, maintain safety records, conduct risk assessments, develop safe work procedures, lead workplace inspections and investigations. The incumbent will also respond and provide guidance on any Improvement Orders that are issued to the College. They will assist several Workplace Safety and Health Committees in their duties as well as provide member training.
