Using simple hand tools and occasional use of power tools. Providing assistance to WWTP Operations in their daily activities Providing assistance to WWTP maintenance tradespeople. Making safety a priority and supporting the achievement of a 'zero injury' culture by: reviewing hazard risk assessments preparing and following daily Safe Work Plans complying with all PPE requirements Other duties as required.

What's required to be successful Grade 12 diploma or GED is required. Must have a valid Class 5 license and a Class 3A (with 6 demerits or less) is an asset. A Driver Abstract will be required. Must be able to meet the physical demands of the position which include heavy manual work in all weather conditions. Clearance on pre-placement medical and drug and alcohol testing will be required. Previous Labour and/or maintenance experience in an industrial environment would be an asset. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills. A high level of safety awareness. Analytical thinking, mechanical aptitude and problem solving skills. Ability to work independently without supervision. Ability to create and maintain supportive and collaborative relationships with colleagues.
